The Texas Public Education Grant (TPEG) for Continuing Education (CE) is a need-based grant that helps to cover a portion of CE tuition and fees. This application must be submitted to the Student Financial Aid Office each term you are enrolled in CE courses.

Student Eligibility Requirements

- Must be registered in a CE program
- Must enroll in at least 40 clock hours •
- Must be registered with Selective Service or be ٠ exempt. Complete attached form to verify.
- Must submit a FAFSA or TASFA
- Must have financial need
- Must be a Texas resident

TPEG Awarding Regulations

- You must pay the cost of any remaining charges on your student bill not covered by TPEG. ٠
- TPEG will not be awarded if you are already receiving VA Benefits, Hazlewood, or other tuition benefits that cover the full cost of your tuition and fees.
- TPEG will not be awarded to cover a CE course previously paid.
