The initial default password will be the first 2 characters of your last name, in upper case followed by month (2 digits), day (2 digits), and year of your birthday (2 digits). For example, my name is Joe Smith and my birthday is January 2, 1966. My initial password would be SM010266.



After the default password information is submitted, the system will ask you to change your password. When you change your default password, you will be asked to provide Secret Questions and Answers.

Financial Aid Key Items

- 1. Verify your name, date of birth, and social security number are correct on your current ApplyTexas application. Inconsistent biographical data (name, date of birth, or social security number) between the FAFSA and the ApplyTexas must be corrected before Financial Aid eligibility can be determined (See Enrollment Services office or online FAFSA.)
- 2. You must be admitted with your official transcript on file to be eligible for Financial Aid.
 - Verify on the Enrollment Checklist that #1. Transcript Status indicates "Complete"
 - If the status is "Incomplete" and your most recent transcript was submitted, contact your college's Admissions / Enrollment Services office
- 3. Once your transcript status is "Complete" and you are admitted, you will have access to the ACES Student and My Page tabs. Continue to monitor your financial aid application requirements and status in the Financial Aid Checklist on My Page. All financial aid requirements listed on My Page must be completed for final eligibility determination.

What is needed to take the TSI Exam?

Please review the complete list of items needed in order to test:

- Must have completed an ApplyTexas application for one of the Alamo Colleges at ApplyTexas or have an active application on file at one of the Alamo Colleges District.
- Login to ACES, select the "Start Here" tab, checklist items 1, 2, and 3 must be completed before you are eligible to test.
- Click on the "Enroll" buttons to begin and complete the required Alamo Enroll modules (Test Prep Module and GO FAARR module).
- > A valid picture ID (State ID, Federal ID, Student ID, Passport, etc.) No exceptions
- Banner ID Number Get My Banner ID Number
- TSI Fees -Full Exam \$32, Single Subject \$12. Cash, electronic checks or credit cards accepted. Please pay for the exam at our testing center, testing fees are non-refundable.
- > No Appointment needed to take the TSI Exam, please see the walk-in times on website.
