












### Freshmen 3-Year Transfer Rates












# Students employed and/or enrolled within 6 months of Graduation












#### **4-Year Freshmen Comparative Graduation Rates**












# Percentage of Students Rating their Entire Educational Experience as "Good or Excellent"










### **Number of High-Challenge Courses**












### **Degrees & Certificates Awarded by Gender**












### **Degrees & Certificates Awarded by Ethnicity**




