The Home College of the student must be SPC. This scholarship amount will be \$500.00 for part time and \$1000.00 for full time students.

- 1. A completed Scholarship Application (Incomplete applications will not be considered).
- 2. Compose a 500-word typed essay outlining your career plans, commitment to completing your college degree, and commitment to the project initiative.
- 3. Provide SPC transcripts that show all grades that apply to your degree.
- Submit a Recommendation form from at least 2 persons, such as a supervisor or other person able to comment on your professional performance. (No relatives or classmates please.)
- 5. Participate in an interview with Project Initiative Director and/or designee.

You must also:

- 1. Be enrolled at St. Philip's College during the semester in which you apply.
- 2. Have and maintain an cumulative GPA of 2.5 to receive the scholarship.
